It is my profound pleasure to welcome all of you on this auspicious occasion of the Fifth Convocation of Dr. D. Y. Patil Vidyapeeth, Pune. It gives me great pleasure to welcome Hon'ble Shri. Shriniwas Patil, Governor of Sikkim. We are extremely grateful to you Sir, for agreeing to spend your valuable time to inspire our students and provide them your experienced counsel regarding life and education. This is a very special moment, since we are blessed with the presence of an iconic visionary like Hon'ble Dr. D. Y. Patil, Governor of Bihar and founder Chancellor of the university. Sir, we have been receiving your wise counsel, support and encouragement in all our endeavours towards achieving excellence.

It is my privilege to congratulate all the grandaunts, their teachers and parents. Degrees will be awarded in this Convocation to a total of 416 undergraduate, 333 postgraduate students and 10 Ph.D. fellows who have completed their studies and passed the examinations during this period. University medals will be awarded to 19 candidates who have secured highest marks in different disciplines.

Dr. D. Y. Patil Vidyapeeth, Pune through its activities of teaching, research and extension has contributed significantly to the creation and dissemination of knowledge relevant to the need of the society. It has gained a unique place on the national academic map through its quality researches both in area of fundamental disciplines and other emerging areas. As a result of the intellectual acumen and incessant devotion of its teaching community, DPU takes immense pride in creating professionals who are globally competitive and locally responsive. The undergraduate and postgraduate courses are designed to build a strong foundation, while also offering a wide range of value added and innovative courses.

Let me take this opportunity to share with you some of the recent achievements and incessant developments at Dr. D. Y. Patil Vidyapeeth Pune. There are many milestones that DPU has crossed this year. Some of our institutes have figured high in rankings released by various agencies, be it the Faculty of Medicine, or Faculty of Dentistry. I cannot do justice to all the important landmarks attained by DPU during the year, but let it suffice to say that there are many, and I am sure more will follow in the days to come.



At the heart of this effort is the conscious development of innovative curricula that prepare professionals for the demands and challenges of the 21st century. The university has created unique learning experiences that focus on all-round student development. It provides market-driven curricula, developed, tested and continually improved upon by faculty and other stakeholders through regular outcomes assessment. The curricula aim at providing competency-based patient-centered education in medical and health sciences. Recently Ministry of Health and Family Welfare Government of India has given its approval to start MD in Emergency Medicines, which is first such programme in Pune region.

Research

Across its academic departments, the University can boast of the commendable performance of its faculty members, particularly of their quality research output, which is evinced by nearly 450 publications since the last convocation in various peer-reviewed, national and international journals as well as conference proceedings, books and monographs. The Ph.D. programme in the University has also enhanced considerably during the recent years. Presently, there are 199 registered doctoral students. All thesis and research publications are checked for plagiarism through software available in the Vidyapeeth. It is not possible to give a full list of publications in esteemed refereed journals and individual research funding received, however, an account of some achievements given below, is an indication of the quality of research at DPU today.

- Recently 29 ICMR-STS projects have been sanctioned by ICMR to our Medical College, which is probably the highest number of projects sanctioned by ICMR to a single Medical College during 2014. Similarly 6 ICMR-STS projects have been approved for our Dental College.
- Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA), had sanctioned two joint research projects between our university and University of Skövde during 2011-12 for a sum of Rs. 66 lakh. It is my pleasure to report that both these projects have been successfully completed and apart from number of papers published, it is also proposed to submit a joint patent to the competent authorities. Similarly three ongoing research projects sanctioned by DST for about Rs. 90 lakh to DPU have provided excellent opportunity to our faculty and students to work on applied aspects.
- Institute of Biotechnology has already submitted five more research projects to external funding agencies for more than one Crore.
- Department of Paediatrics of the Medical College has received a grant of Rs. 30 lakh from Panacea (WHO) for developing EPI Polio Vaccine to find out Polio End-Game Strategy.
- Department of Oral Pathology and Microbiology of the Dental College, has received a grant of Rs. 8.5 Lakh from ICMR for Study of oral psychosomatic disorders in caregivers of oral squamous cell carcinoma patients and their co-relation with salivary cortisol level, salivary dehydroepiandrosterone levels and psychological factors.



International Research Collaborations:

DPU has been able to achieve the highest levels of teaching and research in the health care by mentoring some of the finest students, producing outstanding research publications and achieving pathbreaking research findings. International assignments for Teaching, Research and Consultancy and for exploring possible exchanges are a regular feature at DPU. The International linkages of DPU have helped it in drawing upon the wisdom built up at the partner institutions of repute.

- The Department of Global Health Education John Hopkins University, plans collaboration with the
 medical and nursing institutes of DPU to provide global health training to their students at DPU by
 fostering a collaborative learning environment. Last year a group of engineering and medical
 students from John Hopkins University were with us to discuss the development of innovative and
 low cost medical devices.
- DPU is soon starting an inter-disciplinary collaborative research project with the John Hopkins University on "Pattern of Antibiotic Resistance in Febrile Illness Cases" which will involve the Departments of Microbiology along with the Department of Medicine & Department of Paediatrics of our Medical College.
- Since March 2012, DPU is regularly participating in India HIV Case discussion, through video conference on every third Wednesday conducted by Department of Clinical Global Health Education, John Hopkins University, with number of participating centers & this program is witnessed live worldwide in many countries & recently our undergraduate students also had an opportunity to interact with John Hopkins medical students to discuss Integrated approach to Coronary Artery Disease.
- Indo-Tunisia Joint project entitled 'Comparative Study of Actinomycetes Biodiversity in India and Tunisia: under the POC with Tunisian Government funded by DST has already generated very interesting results.
- Under a MoU of DPU with University of Hong Kong, for Collaborative Research in the areas of Dentistry, our faculty Dr. Aneesha Acharya, is pursuing a joint collaborative research project titled "Microbiological and Host-Response Bio-Markers of Peri-implant Mucositis at Hong Kong for partial completion of her M.Phil degree from University of Hong Kong.
- Linnaeus Palme programme for supporting long term collaboration between Sweden & India, initiated in 2012, has been operationalised with the faculty exchange between two universities.
- Following collaboration of DPU with the highest body of Dental Implantology of World, Academy of Osseo integration USA, as Indian Charter. "Centre of Excellence for Dental Implants" is been established in the Dental College

- Medical College of DPU has been selected to be a part of The Rajiv Gandhi Jeevandai Arogya Yojana by Government of Maharashtra, wherein, cashless medical facilities are provided to large population of this semi urban region.
- All indoor patients in our hospital are provided free treatment along with highly hygienic diet. All
 types of sophisticated investigations such as MRI, CT Scan, Mammography, Colour Doppler,
 Ultrasonography, 2D Echo, are carried out free of cost for indoor patients.
- **Dental College** has organized more than 250 outreach programmes in collaboration of various NGO's around Pune District. The department also functions as the tobacco cessation centre, wherein, assistance is given to patients who want to quit tobacco habit.
- The Department of Pediatrics has started "Yashoda Human Milk Bank". It is the first Human Milk Bank in Pimpri-Chinchwad area and second in Pune District. More than 100 low birth weight and preterm babies received Human Milk from this bank monthly which helps for the survival of these babies.
- Nursing students participated for **Pulse Polio Programme** from 19th January 2014 to 24th January 2014 in PCMC & Alandi area, wherein 8,086 Polio Doses were administrated during their visit to 29,741 Houses in the area.

Infrastructure

Various equipments like High-end 128 slice CT scan, 1.5 Tesla MRI are available in the hospital, keeping in view the tertiary health care facilities, which is commensurate with matched Clinical laboratory support with latest equipments catering more than 10,000 investigations per day. Eye bank with eye ball retrieval service round the clock along with renal and corneal transplant facilities are also available. The college and the hospital functions so well, that we can actually work at that interface between the bench and the bedside which ensures us to undertake research that will bring the real benefits to the healthcare system. The seven story Hi-Tech hospital with a capacity for 1500 patient beds is having state of art JCI standard Department of Emergency Medicine, with its own Operation Theater, Labour room, and diagnostic equipment for management of emergency patients round the clock. Shortly 18 operation theaters of international standards for Cardiac, Neuro, Organ Transplant, Joint replacement, Robotic and other advanced surgeries will become functional. DPU is setting up a state of art Implant Centre at the Dental College for excellence in Implant care for teaching, research & collaborative exchange across the globe. I am happy to announce that we will soon be starting a full-fledged Research Centre, which will provide excellent opportunity for fundamental research in life sciences.
