This is a very special moment, since we are blessed with the presence of the iconic visionaries such as Hon'ble Shri. CH. Vidyasagar Rao, Governor of Maharashtra and Hon'ble Dr. D. Y. Patil, Former Governor of Bihar.

It is my privilege to congratulate all the graduands, their teachers and parents. Degrees are being awarded at this Convocation to a total of 424 undergraduate, 324 postgraduate students and 23 Ph.D. fellows who have completed their studies and passed the examinations during this period. University Gold Medals will be awarded to 19 candidates who have secured highest marks in different disciplines.

Today we are conferring Honoris Causa degrees to three eminent personalities of India. It is not that we are honoring these three eminent personalities, but in fact they have honored us and the society at large, by accepting the Honoris Causa degrees from our Vidyapeeth. DPU will be proud to have such distinguished personalities as our Alumni.

Kindly allow me to take this opportunity to share with you some of the recent achievements and persistent developments at Dr. D. Y. Patil Vidyapeeth, Pune. There are many milestones that DPU has crossed during the passing year.

In March, 2015 Vidyapeeth has been reaccredited by **NAAC** with a **CGPA** of **3.62** on a four point scale at **A grade**, which is presently the highest **CGPA** awarded to Health Science

University and fifth amongst all the universities in India by NAAC. I can possibly do justice to all the landmarks attained by DPU during last year only through the acknowledgment to all of the deserving graduates and academics that DPU has produced.

The Health fraternity has been the biggest facet of DPU and we are proud that we have been able to be on the forefront of transformation of the societal and national spirit by being indisputable and persuasive for the cause which we believe in.

Dr. D. Y. Patil Vidyapeeth, Pune, strives to uphold international educational standards and develop a holistic world view among students. It provides unique learning solution that combines pedagogically sound and comprehensive courses for a variety of subjects with innovative learning and teaching resources focused on all-round student development. The curricula are designed to prepare students to skillfully meet challenges. They provide market-driven programmes and studies, developed, tested and continually improved upon by the faculty and other stakeholders through the assessment of outcomes and aimed at providing competency based, patient centered education in health sciences.



We, at Dr. D. Y. Patil Vidyapeeth focus on evolving and advancing the talent that has strong foundation in scientific research and in turn is/ would be able to cater & deliver the service towards the social and economic development of India. We provide our faculty the academic freedom, time, and resources to pursue their research at the highest levels of productivity. The Vidyapeeth can boast of the commendable performance of its faculty members, particularly for of their quality research output, which is demonstrated by nearly 500 publications since

the last convocation in various peer-reviewed, national and international journals as well as conference proceedings, books and monographs. The Ph.D. programme in the University has also enhanced considerably during the recent years. Presently, there are 164 registered doctoral students. All thesis and research publications are checked for plagiarism through software available in the Vidyapeeth. Six Indian patents are filed from our Biotechnology Institute, of which one is on purification of water, one on DNA binding clues and four on probiotics.

Furthermore, two patents by a PhD scholar under faculty of Medicine for his work on gut sonography imaging have been registered.

It is not possible to give a full list of publications in esteemed refereed journals and individual research funding received, however, an account of some achievements given below is an indication of the quality of research at DPU.

- Recently 36 ICMR-STS projects have been sanctioned by ICMR to our Medical College, which is probably the highest number of projects sanctioned by ICMR to a single Medical College during 2015. Similarly 11 ICMR-STS projects have been approved for our Dental College.
- 7 concept documents by staff members under faculty of medicine are approved by ICMR.
- Institute of Biotechnology, has received a grant of SEK 1,70,000 (Rs. 12.85 Lakh) from FORMAS, Swedish Research Council, Sweden for Joint Project of "The emergence and persistence of novel resistance to 3rd

- generation cephalosporin and carbapenem in bacteria in the environment" with University of Orebro and University of Skovde, Sweden.
- Department of Oral Pathology (Dental) has received a grant of USD 24,806 (Rs. 16.00 Lakh) from International Team of Implantology (ITI), Switzerland for project of "Comparative evaluation of the antibacterial effect, adhesion of gingival fibroblast and epithelial attachment to titanium, zirconium and titanium with silver nano coatings".
- Institute of Biotechnology has received a grant of Rs. 22.63 Lakh from DST for project of "Exploitation of abnormal DNA repair in cancer as a strategy for cancer therapy". Similarly three ongoing research projects sanctioned by DST for about Rs. 90 lakh to DPU have provided excellent opportunity to our faculty and students towork on applied aspects.
- Institute of Biotechnology has already submitted ten more research projects worth Rs. 10 crores to external funding agencies.



INTERNATIONAL RESEARCH COLLABORATIONS

International assignments for Teaching, Research & Consultancy and for exploring possible exchanges are a regular feature at DPU. In order to expand students' horizons and generate job opportunities, DPU has collaborated with many reputed institutions worldwide. The International linkages of DPU have helped it in drawing upon the wisdom built up at the partner institutions of repute.

 The Department of Global Health Education, Johns Hopkins University has sent their students in batches to the medical and nursing institutes of DPU to provide global health training to their students at DPU by fostering a collaborative learning environment under their Global Heath leadership programme. Last year a group of engineering and medical students from John Hopkins University were with us to discuss the development of innovative and low cost patented medical devices for developing countries.

collaborative research project with Johns Hopkins University on "Bacterial and antimicrobial resistance pattern in Pune, India in febrile illness" which will involve the Departments of Microbiology along with the Department of Medicine & Department of

- Pediatric of our Medical College. Two more projects on TB are already approved and are expected to be launched after requisite permissions.
- Since March 2012, DPU is regularly participating in India HIV Case discussion, through video conference on every third Wednesday conducted by Department of Clinical Global Health Education, John Hopkins University, with number of participating centers & this program is witnessed live worldwide in many countries & recently our undergraduate students also had an opportunity to interact with John Hopkins medical students to discuss Integrated approach to Coronary Artery Disease. Students of medical college participated in online training on Global Health issues and 46 of them were awarded certificates for successful completion of course.
- A National Workshop on "Public Health Preparedness, Response and Medical Management" was hosted by Dr. D. Y. Patil Vidyapeeth, Pune, in collaboration with Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Atlanta, USA, National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), Govt. of India and All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi, on 24th and 25th April 2015. 210 delegates from all over the country attended the event.
- DPU organized a CME on "Psychiatric Neurosciences" in Collaboration with Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU), Virginia, USA on 10th & 11th June 2015.
- The research project entitled "Comparative study of actinomycetes biodiversity in India and Tunisia: investigation of biotechnological enzymes and biological

- activities" is jointly funded by Department of Science & Technology, Govt. of India and Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research of the Republic of Tunisia for the duration March 2013 to February 2016 for ongoing research collaboration between Enzyme Engineering Laboratory & Microbiology, Ecole Nationale D'Ingenieurs de Sfax, Tunisia and Dr. D. Y. Patil Biotechnology and Bioinformatics.
- The Department of Dermatology is developing a strategy for etiopathogenesis (genetic as well as environmental) and managing (prevention as well as treatment) Vitiligo in collaboration with CSIR-IGIV.
- Dr. D. Y. Patil Biotechnology and Bioinformatics Institute in collaboration with University of Skovde, Sweden is in the process of developing COPD bio-markers for a designing of preventive and therapeutic strategies for COPD with special reference to Indian rural population.
- The DPU Unit of the International Bioethics Network of the UNESCO Chair in Bioethics was inaugurated on 30th May 2015 at the hands of Prof. Russell D'Souza, Head, and Asia Pacific Bioethics Program of the UNESCO Chair in Bioethics.
- Biotechnology institute successfully completed student exchange programme with ENIS, Tunisia where a student of Biotechnology Institute of DPU visited ENIS for duration of one month & a student from ENIS visited DPU for duration of 3 weeks. This exchange under Indo-Tunisian collaboration was funded by Department of Science & Technology, Govt. of India & Ministry of higher education & Scientific Research, Tunisia.

It also needs to be reckoned in terms of the value addition, by the institution, to the different stakeholders with different needs and expectations. Vidyapeeth has also developed a very effective interface with the society, through sustainable health care for underserved population, with special attention given to women and children in different villages through trainings, workshops, resource mobilization and technical support to improve the maternal and child health status in the community at large.

- All indoor patients in our hospital are provided free treatment along with highly hygienic diet.
 All types of sophisticated investigations such as MRI, CT Scan, Mammography, Colour Doppler, Ultrasonography, 2D Echo, are carried out free of cost for indoor patients.
- The Vidyapeeth has actively participated in the relief work for natural calamities like the floods in Kashmir and the landslide at Malin Village in Pune district. A multi-disciplinary health camp was organised by the Department of Community Medicine in association with the health Department of Maharashtra State and Zilla Parishad, Pune, at PHC Adivare near Malin, Fee waiver has also been given to our students, whose family has suffered due the recent floods in Kashmir.
- The Departments of Community Medicine, Public Health Dentistry and extension wings / cells of other institutions as well as NSS unit undertake extension and outreach activities

- throughout the year as per systematic plan and strategies. The rural and urban primary health centres at Alandi and Ajmera as well as satellite centres help in developing linkage between community, government, NGOs and DPU.
- As contribution to maternal and new born safety programs we have adopted 6 primary health centers where expectant mothers are examined and treated. We promote institutional deliveries and to facilitate this we have deployed an ambulance in the area (24X7) to transport women in labor from village to hospital free of cost.
- The 'Yashoda' Human Milk Bank run by the Department of Paediatrics has proved its value as a highly relevant social outreach activity to help in reducing neonatal morbidity and mortality in the area. This is the first of its kind to be started in a private medical college in Pune. The services are provided free of cost and are used mostly by people from lower socio-economic strata.
- DPU has implemented government schemes like Rajiv Gandhi Arogyadayee Yojana (2013). Sharda Gram Arogya Sanjivani Yojana (2012) and Mission Uday Kishore for adolescent care.

INFRASTRUCTURE

DPU has always endeavored to deliver quality education in a globally benchmarked learning environment through modern amphitheatrestyled air-conditioned classrooms, hi-tech labs and libraries which require tremendous encouragement and resources for which we have got active support from our President Dr. P. D. Patil.

Not only has the physical infrastructure been extensively modernized, the facilities and equipment have improved at a faster pace. Various equipments like High-end 128 slice CT scan, 1.5 Tesla MRI are available in the hospital. Keeping in view the tertiary health care facilities, on an average 5000 laboratory diagnostics, 800 imaging procedures and 1000 other diagnostics procedures are done every day. Out of 18 modular OT to be commissioned, construction of 8 imported OT has been completed. 9 intensive care

units, with 140 beds catering to all disciplines, to name a few, transplant, burns, airborne infection isolation, trauma care are in the process of final commissioning. Expansion of hemodialysis services with 25 machines with an objective to serve 100 dialysis per day has been completed. Cardiac Cath labs with one electro physiology equipment are ready to serve the needy patients. It is proposed that in near future the IVF center, Epilepsy surgery center, Bone marrow transplantation services and multi disciplinary tumor clinic with special attention to breast disease will be started.

DPU has established a state-of-art Implant Centre at the Dental College for excellence in Implant care for teaching, research & collaborative exchange across the globe. I am happy to announce that DPU has granted Rs.5 Cr. towards the Central Research Facility which has



been established during this year which is an interdisciplinary research initiative integrating various disciplines of Life Science. This new facility, I am sure will provide a further fillip to our research activities

We have a demonstrated commitment to quality. We also carry a legacy of a strong foundation for academic excellence. Being young citizens, all of you- the children of DPU- have the responsibility to work for Universal harmony by ironing out all the causes of conflicts in your zone of activities and also beyond.

One of the towering personalities in the contemporary Indian Polity is, Shri. Sharadchandra Govindrao Pawar, born on 12^a December, 1940. He is popularly known as the front runner for the cause of Maharashtra and especially the farming community. Shri. Sharad Pawar was educated in this very city of Pune. He was Member / Chairman of various important Parliamentary Committees and also the JPCs. He was Union Minister of Defence (1991-93) and Minister of Agriculture (2004-2014). He holds a rarest distinction of not losing a single election. He is a founder President of Nationalist Congress Party (NCP).

Shri. Sharad Pawar is known to be an able and highly respected pro-people and a nationalist politician, veteran purliamentarian, committed social worker, visionary agriculturalist, proven administrator, capable educationist, sports administrator and passionate environmentalist. We are extremely proud to honour Dr. Raghunath Anant Mashelkar today. He is a pioneering scientist, whose towering contributions in both science as well as science leadership have been applauded all over the world. Formerly the President of Indian National Science Academy, Dr. Mashelkar is currently the President of Global Research Alliance, a network of publicly funded R&D institutes from Asia-Pacific, Europe and USA with over 60,000 scientists.

Dr. Mashelkar served with great distinction as the Director General of Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), with forty laboratories and about 20,000 employees for over eleven years. The transformation of CSIR under his leadership into a performance driven and accountable organization has been recognised as one of the top ten achievements of Indian science in the 20th century.

Dr. Mashelkar has been honoured internationally. For instance, in over 350 years of the history of Royal Society, London, Dr. Mashelkar is the only Maharashtrian so far to have been elected as Fellow of Royal Society, an honour, which is considered as next to Nobel Prize. He was elected Foreign Associate of National Academy of Science (USA) - only the 8th Indian since 1870 to be so elected. He was elected Associate Foreign Member, American Academy of Arts & Sciences - only the 7th Indian to have been elected so far since 1780.

In 1998, Dr. Mashelkar won the JRD Tata Corporate Leadership Award, the only scientist to win it so far. In 2005, he received the Business Week (USA) award of 'Stars of Asia' at the hands of George Bush (Sr.), the former President of USA. He was the first Asian Scientist to receive it.

Currently the Chairman of India's National Innovation Foundation, Dr. Mashelkar has been considered as a pioneer in the Intellectual Property Rights movement in India. He spearheaded the successful challenge to the US patent on the use of turmeric for wound healing and also the patent on Basmati rice. These fights, besides creating the Traditional Knowledge Digital Library, gave the Indian traditional knowledge its rightful place in the Universal Knowledge Systems.

In the post-liberalized India, Dr. Mashelkar has played a critical role in shaping India's S&T policies. He was a member of the Scientific Advisory Council to the Prime Minister set up by successive governments since 1985. He has chaired twelve high powered so called 'Mashelkar Committees' dealing with complex issues of national importance.

Thirty three universities from around the world have honoured Dr. Mashelkar with honorary doctorates. The President of India honoured Dr. Mashelkar with Padmashri (1991), with Padmabhushan (2000) and with Padma Vibhushan (2014).

As a token of recognition of his outstanding science and science leadership, and especially for his pathbreaking efforts that enabled India to hold its head high in science, technology and innovation in the global setting. I am most grateful to the Vidyapeeth for doing me this wonderful honor. I especially feel honored that I'm receiving this honorary doctorate at the hands of our beloved and most revered Honorable President of India. I am also very happy that I am receiving this honor in my city, my great city of Pune with D.Y. Patil Vidyapeeth which is setting up new standards of excellence, new benchmarks in both education and research coupled with innovation. It's a great institution which is on the rise and I'm very proud to be its alumnus. I promise you as its proud alumnus that I'll do whatever I can to enhance the reputation of this great institution even further. It is true that I've been singled out as Raghunath Mashelkar for this honor but I really owe it to several-several people; my students, my gurus who showed me the way, my 20,000 colleagues for my CSIR family, whom I had the privilege to serve and lead for 11 years, this entire city of Pune which has given me such love for 40 years, encouraged me, and my family who is here, who did not mind me dedicating my life to the nation 24x7, day after day, week after week, month after month, year after year. But there is one person to whom I would like to dedicate this degree. And that is my mother.

My background is well known to you. Born in a very poor family, this poor widow came to Mumbai. She was illiterate; she was always in search of jobs every day. I studied under street lights as you know. But it was she, being uneducated, understood the value of education and said "education is the future". I remember when I was young and I would get 100 out of 100 in Maths but occasionally I would get 97. I was very happy with that 97 but she would sit there and say "Ramesh, where did you lose those 3 marks?". Setting very high benchmarks! And I remember one instance which was a big change in our life. She had gone in search of a job to what is called Congress House near Prarthana Samaj in Bombay, waiting in the queue, and she did not get the job because she had not finished her 3rd standard. Of course she could have lied and said I am a 3rd standard pass, but she did not. And on the way out she said "I am going to make sure that my son studies the highest ever degree and meets the highest ever education qualifications there are". So, after my SSC, I was going to leave the school but she said 'no, you must study'. I became B. Chem. Engg. and said to her "now I will take up a job". She said no. She, that uneducated lady had found out that there is a PhD. And when I finished my PhD, she said no, there's a post doctor research fellowship. She continued like this and I remember in 2006 she passed away and 3 months before her passing I had got my 25th honorary doctorate and then I went to her and told her this. She said "now I'm satisfied, now I can go". And 3 months after that, she was gone. So ladies and gentlemen I am here because of her. I am standing here because of her, so this honor goes to her, not me. Thank you very much.

CONVOCATION

Good evening. Honourable Governor Vidyasagar Rao, Governor of Maharashtra; Shri Girish Bapat, Honourable Minister Food Civil Supplies and Consumer Protections, Government of Maharashtra; Shri D. Y.Patil, former Governor of Bihar; Shri SharadPawar, MP Rajya Sabha; AbhijeetMukerjee, MP Lok Sabha; Dr. R. A. Mashelkar, National Research Professor, national chemical laboratory, Pune; Sir P D Patil, President D. Y.PatilVidyapeeth; Professor R. N.Razdan, Vice Chancellor D. Y.PatilVidyapeeth; distinguished deans and faculties; members of the Board of Management; distinguished faculty and staff members; recipients of degrees, awards& medals; dear students; distinguished guests, ladies and gentlemen. I am indeed very happy to have the opportunity of being present on this happy occasion of the 6th convocation of D.Y. PatilVidyapeeth.

Pune, for a very long period of time, has acquired its fame and carved a place in the nation and outside, for its learning. A number of magnificent institutions, including D. Y.PatilVidyapeeth, have flourished in this region and have made immense contributions to the field of higher education in different branches and disciplines. Education is the key to the success of achieving the desired goal in life. Education not only enhances our capacity to learn and absorb but also to illuminate the society. It provides basic empowerment to a human being for marching steadily towards his goal. This Vidyapeeth was established in 2003 with a vision 'to see enlightened, cultured and economically vibrant India, developed through education in diverse disciplines'. Under the inspiring leadership of Dr. P.D. Patil and a team of highly dedicated teachers, this Institute has over the last twelve years contributed significantly towards the fulfillment of this objective.

I congratulate all of you for the progress made so far in terms of its remarkable growth and enhanced prestige. It is heartening to note that this Institute has been awarded with an 'A' grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council. University is at the top of the formal education pyramid. It is, therefore, incumbent on universities to guide the direction of progress of the society. Ancient India had a tradition of worldclass learning institutions, represented by renowned universities at Takshashila, Nalanda, Vikramashila, Valabhi, Odantapuri and Somapura. These seats of learning dominated the world education system in higher education for eighteen hundred years and these institutions, like a magnet, attracted talented teachers and students from far and abroad. Not only Megasthenes and Wong Chang but a host of other scholars from China, Persia, Greece, and many other countries flocked around these universities, and through the cultivation of knowledge, education, and innovation human beings of the world were enlightened and benefited. Unfortunately, we could not retain that position with the destruction of Nalanda in the 12thcentury AD; the dominance of almost 1500 years in the world education scenario was lost to us. I am making this point almost as a ritual because my intention is not to ensure that some Indian institutions find their rightful place in the grading system of the world grading systems by reputed world rating agencies, but because I do believe along with the physical expansion of the higher educational infrastructure it is equally important that the quality of the education which we impart must improve substantially and be of world standard. And if we make efforts, we can achieve this, as we did in the past. That is the sole objective of making these remarks, almost like a parrot, in every educational congregation.

A higher ranking boosts the morale of students and teachers by increasing their growth opportunities. It can also help retain meritorious students who otherwise want to avail of higher education inforeign countries.

Right now, while I'm speaking before you, despite the existence of more than 730 universities, 36000 colleges, 30 NIITs, 16 IITs and scores of institutes of management, IIACRs, 200,000 students of India, right now, are having their educations in foreign universities. We can reverse this process by improving the process of higher learning. How do we transform our universities into great learning centers? At first, there is need to link education with research and innovation in a seamless manner. Education disseminates knowledge while research creates new knowledge. Innovation converts that knowledge into wealth and social good. Promoting interdisciplinary research and research at under-graduate level, boosting collaborative research and joint research papers, and encouraging bright students to enter the research field are some of the steps required in this direction. Emphasis is being laid on research at the Vidyapeeth right from the beginning. I am glad to know that a PhD programme in all specialties was started in 2009 and today 22 PhD degrees have been confirmed. Particular focus is called for nurturing innovative ideas. The ingenuity of the grassroots innovators requires mentoring for development of viable products useful to the common man. Innovation clubs have been set up in several central institutions to act as a bridge between the academic community and innovators. I wish to see such platforms being built in our private institutions as well. Distinguished guests, faculty members, dear students, ladies, and gentlemen; changes needed in academic institutions are multidimensional. Adequate availability of good quality faculty must be ensured. Faculty must use latest pedagogy relying on ICT solutions for effective delivery of instructions. Faculty also must upgrade their knowledge of a subject through participation in refresher courses and seminars. Institutions must create synergy with other institutions for research partnerships, and sharing of course material and subject experts. Institutions must establish networks with the industry for guidance on projects, course design, and internship programmes. Our universities are the torchbearers of socio-economic development. The relevance of their teaching must extend beyond the classrooms, to the society and the nation. At the same time, they must, through their own example usher in socioeconomic change. The Government initiatives aimed at faster economic growth, Swachh Bharat, Adarsh Gram, Digital India and Make-in-India, have the potential to lift India to the state of an advanced nation. Their successful implementation calls for participation by a wide section of the society. Our education, training, research and innovation must contribute to these national objectives.

Distinguished guests, ladies and gentlemen, our education model must not only develop the mind but also create positive mind-sets. Expanding a student's ability must go hand in hand with building his attitude. A creative mind-set combined with a positive attitude can help unearth solutions to problems afflicting the society, like malnutrition, affordable healthcare, efficient energy use, drinking water, and sanitation.

The objective of education is not merely the acquisition of knowledge and the production of competent manpower. At a macro level, education leads to nation-building. At the micro level, it must result in character-building in students. On this revered occasion, I am reminded of a Sanskrit Shubhashit from the Chanakya Niti Shastra.

Chanakya Niti Shastra. I quote:

न चौर हार्यम न च राज हार्यम । न भ्रातृभाज्यम न च भारकारी ।। व्यये कृते वर्धते नित्यं । विद्याधनं सर्वे प्रधानम ।।

"Na chor haryam, na raaj haryam, na bhrata bhajyam na cha bharakaari;

Vyaye krate vardhate eva nityam, vidhya dhanam sarva dhan pradhanam" (unquote).


